Balmain To Host Music Festival In Paris

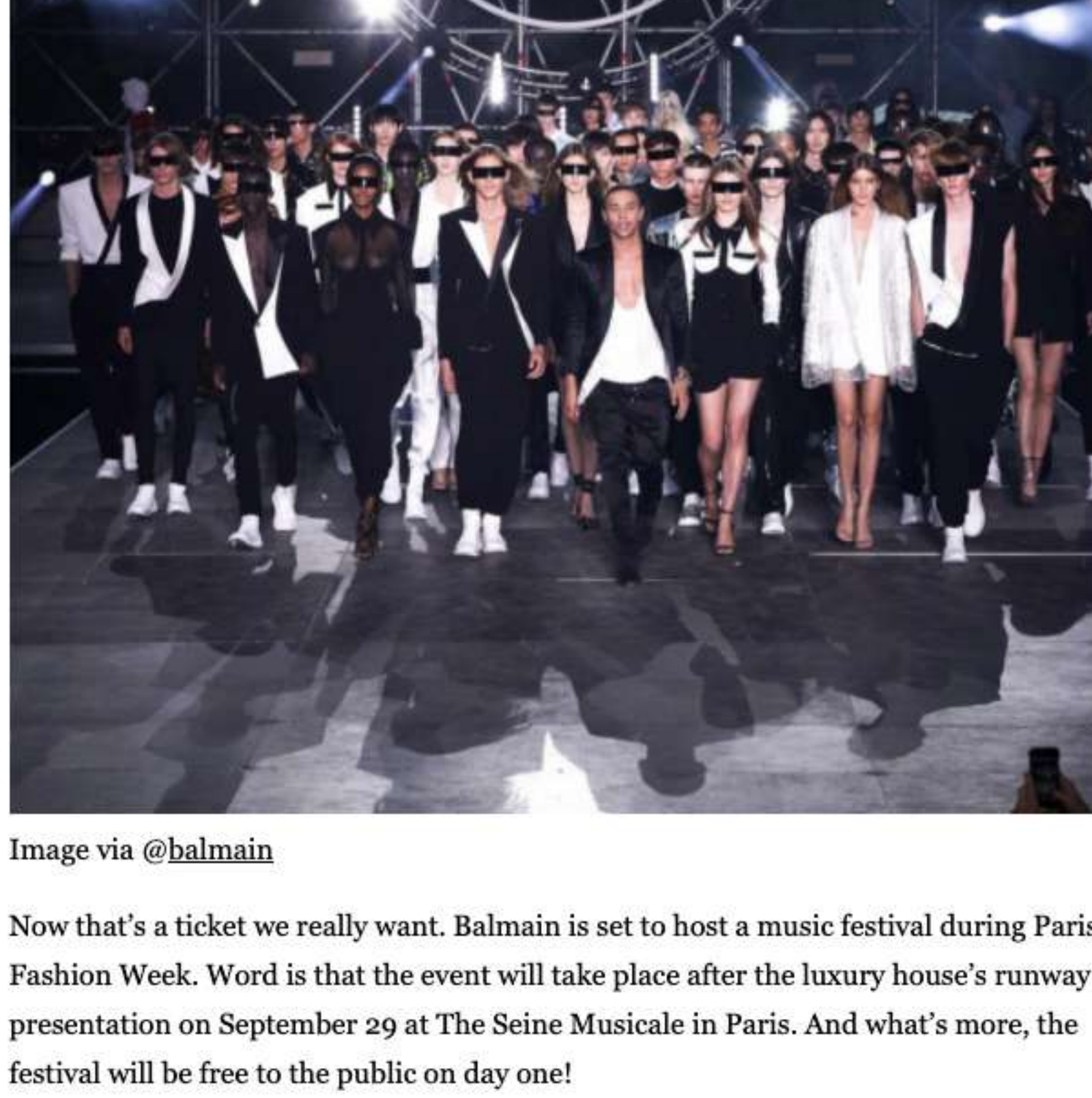

Fake Mona Lisa Makes Millions

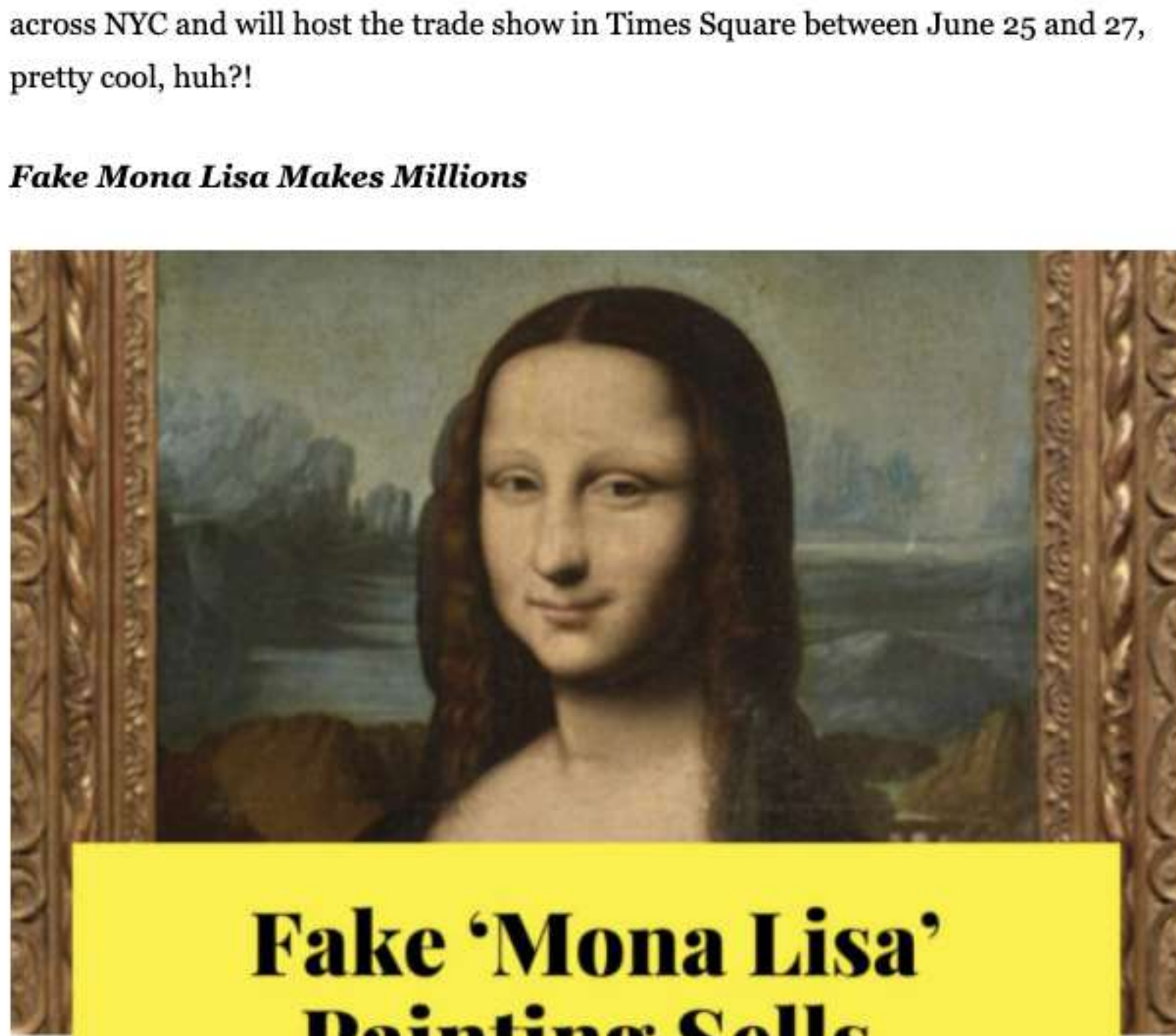
